- ⁷ The memory of the righteous *man* will be a blessing,

But the name of wicked men will rot.

- ⁸ The wise of heart receives commands,
 - But the dense of lips is thrown down.
- ⁹ He who walks with integrity will walk trustfully, But he who twists² his ways will be found out.3

- ¹⁰ The winker of eye will cause⁴ pain,
 - But the dense of lips will be thrown down.
