On the first day of the week, at early dawn, they (Mary Magdalene and the other Mary) went to the tomb, taking the spices they had prepared. and entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting on the right side (an angel), dressed in a white robe, and they were alarmed. And he said to them, "Do not be alarmed. You seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has risen; he is not here. See the place where they laid him.

Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures, and said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead. Luke 24:45-46
