- How the Lord Jesus Christ's authority works today.
- 1. <u>Authority exercised</u>: Christ <u>Makes His Churches</u> of those who are Called to faith in by His Word preached. <u>Eph. 2:20</u>.
 - a. Only through His Word and Spirit is there life and liberty for sin-cursed and sinful humans.
 - b. Salvation & holiness come to them by His Word preached. <u>Rom. 10:17</u>; <u>Acts</u> <u>20:20-21</u>; <u>1 Thess. 2:13</u>. Cf. BCF 1689 26:4-5.
- 2. <u>Authority Assured</u>: Christ's Made Provision for His Word to be continually preached to His Churches. This was a transition from Apostles to Pastors.
 - a. Saved sinners always desperately need the Spirit's Ministry of Jesus' Word.
 - b. To accomplish this, Christ's Apostles required the Provision of Pastors/ Elders/Bishops in His Churches. - <u>Acts 14:23</u>. Cf. BCF 26:6-8.
 - c. Christ intended and gives a constant provision of Pastors and Teachers to His churches. Eph. 4:7-8, 11-12.
- 3. <u>Authority Implemented</u>: Christ's Apostles Ordained NT Church Order, for <u>Preserving Christ's Word to His Churches</u> through the ministry of Pastors/ Elders/Bishops. Here is His great love for us displayed in Five Actions:
 - a. Pastors must be Biblically <u>Qualified</u> to Minister Christ's Word. <u>1 Timothy</u> <u>3:1-2a</u>.
 - b. Pastors must <u>"hold fast" to Christ's Word</u> in order to Minister to Christ's Church. <u>2 Timothy 1:13-14</u>.
 - c. Pastors must <u>follow Christ's Word</u> to Minister to Christ's Church. <u>2</u> <u>Timothy 3:14-17</u>.
 - d. Pastors must Lead the Church by Christ's Word, Studying and Publicly Reading and Preaching it. - 1 Timothy 4:6, 13, 16.
 - e. Pastor's must Faithfully Preach and Teach Christ's Word <u>even when the</u> <u>Church opposes them</u> - <u>2 Timothy 4:1-5</u>. Cf. BCF 26:9-11.
- 4. <u>Authority Maintained</u>: Christ has provided <u>for the continual refilling of the</u> <u>pastoral office</u> through the ministry of the Spirit and the Word, believed and proclaimed by men who desire the office.
 - a. Pastors are to train other <u>qualified men</u> to be pastors. \rightarrow <u>2 Timothy 2:1-2</u>, <u>15</u>; <u>3:10</u>.
 - b. Those men, when recognized so, will then take up pastoral authority in particular congregations. \rightarrow Acts 14:23; Titus 1:5.
- 5. When this method is followed carefully, Christ's authority is exercised, assured, implemented, and maintained by the pastoral office.
