Main Point:

Following Christ is costly, but the benefits of doing so far outweigh the cost; therefore, remember these gracious benefits and keep on following Him, despite the cost.

1. Following Christ is costly.

2. The benefits of following Christ far outweigh the cost.

3. The benefits of following Christ are yours only because of God's grace.

4. Remember these gracious benefits and keep on following Christ, despite the cost.
