#### What is a paradox?

- ✓ a statement or proposition that seems selfcontradictory or absurd
- ✓ a seemingly impossible situation

Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the Kingdom of heaven. Poor in Spirit means Spiritually bankrupt
