TEXT: Psalms 69:1 Save me, O God; for the waters are come in unto my soul.

4 They that hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of mine head...

30 I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify him with thanksgiving.

31 This also shall please the LORD better than an ox or bullock that hath horns and hoofs.

32 The humble shall see this, and be glad...

Ephesians 5:19 Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart **to the Lord;**

**Psalms 42:5 Why art thou cast
down, O my soul? and why art
thou disquieted in me? hope thou
in God: for I shall yet praise him
for the help of his countenance.**

**Hosea 14:2...turn to the LORD:
say unto him, Take away all
iniquity, and receive us
graciously: so will we render the
calves of our lips.**

**Genesis 4:4 And Abel, he
also brought of the
firstlings of his flock...**

**Proverbs 3:9 Honour the LORD
with thy substance, and with the
firstfruits of all thine increase:
10 So shall thy barns be filled with
plenty, and thy presses shall burst
out with new wine.**

**Luke 11:42 But woe unto you,
Pharisees! for ye tithe mint and rue
and all manner of herbs, and pass
over judgment and the love of God:
these ought ye to have done, and
not to leave the other undone.**

**1 Corinthians 9:7...who planteth a vineyard,
and eateth not of the fruit thereof? or who
feedeth a flock, and eateth not of the milk of
the flock?**

**11 If we have sown unto you spiritual things,
is it a great thing if we shall reap your
carnal things?**

13 Do ye not know that they which minister about holy things live of the things of the temple? and they which wait at the altar are partakers with the altar?

14 Even so hath the Lord ordained that they which preach the gospel should live of the gospel.

**2 Corinthians 11:8 I robbed
other churches, taking wages
of them, to do you service.**

Malachi 3:8 Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.

11 And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground...

Malachi 1:13 Ye said also, **Behold, what a weariness is it!** and ye have snuffed at it, saith the LORD of hosts; and **ye brought that which was torn, and the lame, and the sick;** thus ye brought an offering: should I accept this of your hand? saith the LORD.

Hebrews 13:15 By him therefore **let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually,** that is, **the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name.**

16 But to do good and **to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.**

17 Obey them that have the rule over you...

Galatians 6:6 Let him that is taught in the word communicate unto him that teacheth in all good things.

7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

9 And **let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.**

10 As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.

Malachi 1:7 Ye offer polluted bread upon mine altar; and ye say, Wherein have we polluted thee? In that ye say, The table of the LORD is contemptible.

Hosea 14:2...so will we render the calves of our lips.

Hebrews 13:15 By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name.

24 Who, having received such a charge, thrust them into the inner prison, and made their feet fast in the stocks.

Habakkuk 3:17 Although the fig tree shall not blossom, neither shall fruit be in the vines; the labour of the olive shall fail, and the fields shall yield no meat; the flock shall be cut off from the fold, and there shall be no herd in the stalls:

18 Yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will joy in the God of my salvation.

William Gurnall, *The Christian in Compleat Armour*
(1662):
