**Genesis 3:1-4** <sup>1</sup> Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden?'" <sup>2</sup> And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden; <sup>3</sup> "but of the fruit of the tree which *is* in the midst of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die.'" <sup>4</sup> Then the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die. (NKJV)

**Genesis 2:16-17** <sup>16</sup> And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; <sup>17</sup> "but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die." (NKJV)

**John 8:44** <sup>44</sup> ... He was a murderer from the beginning, and has nothing to do with the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies. (ESV)

**Deuteronomy 32:3-4** <sup>3</sup> For I proclaim the name of the LORD: Ascribe greatness to our God. <sup>4</sup> *He is* the Rock, His work *is* perfect; For all His ways *are* justice, A God of truth ... (NKJV)

**Numbers 23:19** <sup>19</sup> God is not man, that he should lie, or a son of man, that he should change his mind. Has he said, and will he not do it? Or has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it? (ESV)

**Dan Doriani** "Even if circumstances change, even if we get a better offer, even if faithfulness becomes difficult, even if the temptation to break a vow seems unbearable, even if keeping the vow brings real loss, even if no one but God will know if we break our vow, we should still do what we say."

**Proverbs 12:22** <sup>22</sup> Lying lips *are* an abomination to the LORD, But those who deal truthfully *are* His delight. (NKJV)

**Isaiah 53:9** <sup>9</sup> And they made His grave with the wicked-- But with the rich at His death, Because He had done no violence, Nor *was any* deceit in His mouth. (NKJV)

**Colossians 3:9-10** <sup>9</sup> Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds, <sup>10</sup> and have put on the new *man* who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him. (NKJV)
