- 1) Make your **body** a living sacrifice (v.1-2).
  - a. We serve God with our **body**.
  - b. We dedicate our bodies to **continual** sacrificial living.
  - c. We dedicate our bodies because it is a holy and <u>acceptable</u> sacrifice.
  - d. To live a constant sacrificial life is our **reasonable** ministry.
- 2) Make yourself **<u>available</u>** to the body (v.3-5).
  - a. Be <u>honest</u> about yourself and your abilities (v.3).
  - b. Be **happy** with the gifts God gave you (v.4-5).
  - c. Be wary of "<u>comparisonitis"</u>.

- 3) Make every effort to <u>discover</u> and use your gift(s) (v.6-8).
  - a. <u>**Claim**</u> your gift. Own it.
  - b. <u>Use</u> your gift. Experience it.
- Make love your default <u>operating system</u> (v.9-13).
- 5) Make your gifted ministry your **primary mission** in life (v.14-21).
