



## ***“Here am I”***

*When God Calls  
Exodus 3:1-10*

*God is calling the:*

**I. Active** - “Moses...led the flock to... the desert” (vs. 1-3)

*He calls the:*

**A. Consistent** – “Moses kept the flock of Jethro”

**B. Conscientious** – “appeared unto him out of ...a bush”

**C. Curious** - “why the bush is not burnt”

**II. Attentive** - “the Lord saw...he had turned aside to see” (vs. 4-6)

*His call is:*

**A. Personal** - “God called unto him...Moses, Moses”

**B. Precious** – “for the place...is holy ground”

**C. Powerful** – “for he was afraid to look upon God”

**III. Affinitive** -“behold, the cry of ... Israel” (vs. 7- 10)

*Affinitive - liking or inclination toward something*

*He calls us to:*

**A. Look** – “I have surely seen the affliction of my people ”

**B. Listen** – “and have heard their cry”

**C. Learn** – “for I know of their sorrows”

*“Our calling is first to Someone (Jesus)  
then to Something and Somewhere.”*
