As stewards of God we are to treasure God and trust His providence.

- 1) God, the Owner of all things, apportions to each according to His holy, wise, and just providence.
 - a) Owner of all things (Psalm 50:10-12)
 - b) Giver of all things (Acts 17:25-26; 1 Timothy 6:17; James 1:17)
 - c) **Application**: Stealing comes in a variety of forms:
 - i) Theft and Receiving Stolen Goods (Eph. 4:28; Prov. 29:24)
 - ii) Using False Weights and Measures (Prov. 11:1; Prov. 20:10)
 - iii) Not Repaying Debts (Psalm 37:21)
 - iv) Bribing, Exorbitant Interest, and Extortion (Ezek. 22:12)
 - v) Withholding Wages (James 5:4)
 - vi) Idleness (2 Thess. 3:6-12)
 - vii) Withholding Charity (1 John 3:17)
 - viii) Withholding Tithes (Mal. 3:8)
 - ix) Envy and Covetousness (Exod. 20:17; Col. 3:5; Eph. 5:3, 5)
 - x) Discontentment (1 Tim. 6:6; Heb. 13:5)
- 2) As His stewards we are to trust God's providence.
 - a) Stealing is a heart/trust issue.
 - i) Disregard for the Interests of Others (Phil. 2:4, 21)
 - ii) Begrudging God (1 Tim. 6:17)
 - iii) Usurping God's Privilege—claiming the right to distribute what belongs to God
 - b) **Application**: The thief does not trust God's providence.
 - i) Do you trust that God knows best?
 - ii) Can you be faithful with the little? (Matt. 25:14-30)
 - iii) Do you want what you want to serve God and others? (Eph. 4:28)
- 3) As His stewards we are to treasure God.
 - a) Covetousness is idolatry (Col. 3:5; Eph. 5:5). Stealing is the acquisition of idols.
 - b) love of money is the enemy of love of God/neighbor (1 Tim. 3:3; 6:10; Heb. 13:5; Matt. 6:24)
 - c) **Application**: Where is your treasure?
 - i) Where is your worship directed?
 - ii) What are your daily liturgies?
 - iii) There is hope in Christ who died between two thieves (Matt. 27:38; Luke 23: 42-43).
