

"Evangelism"

Being a Witness Exodus 18:1-12

A good witness will:

I. Relate - "Moses' father in law" (vs. 1-7)

Our Gospel :

A. Remembers – "Jethro, the priest of Midian"

B. Receives – "Moses went out to meet his father in law"

C. Respects – "did obeisance, and kissed him, and asked"

II. Recite - "And Moses told his father in law all" (vs. 8-9) *Our God:*

A. Defends - "had done unto Pharaoh...for Israel's sake"

B. Directs – "the travail that had come on them by the way"

C. Delivers – "how the Lord had delivered them"

III. Rejoice - "Jethro rejoiced for all the goodness" (vs. 9-12) *Our God is:*

A. Sympathetic – "all the goodness which the Lord had done"

B. Superior - "the Lord is greater than all gods "

C. Sovereign - "wherein they dealt proudly He was above them"

Sentence Sermon:

"Evangelism is simply glorifying God, loving the Lost and giving out the Gospel."
