**Revelation 12**



**Rev. 12:1 - And there appeared a great sign in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars:**



**12:2**

**She was pregnant  
and cried out in pain  
as she was about to  
give birth**



**12:3**

**And there appeared  
another sign in heaven;  
and behold a great red  
dragon, having seven  
heads and ten horns, and  
seven crowns upon his  
heads.**

**12:4a - And his tail  
drew the third part of  
the stars of heaven,  
and cast them to the  
earth:....**





**12:4b - ...and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, to devour her child as soon as it was born.**

**12:5 - And she brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her child was caught up unto God, and [to] his throne.**






**12:6 And the woman  
fled into the  
wilderness, where  
she has a place  
prepared of God,  
that they should feed  
her there a thousand  
two hundred [and]  
sixty days.**





**12:7a - And there was war in  
heaven:**

any more in heaven.**



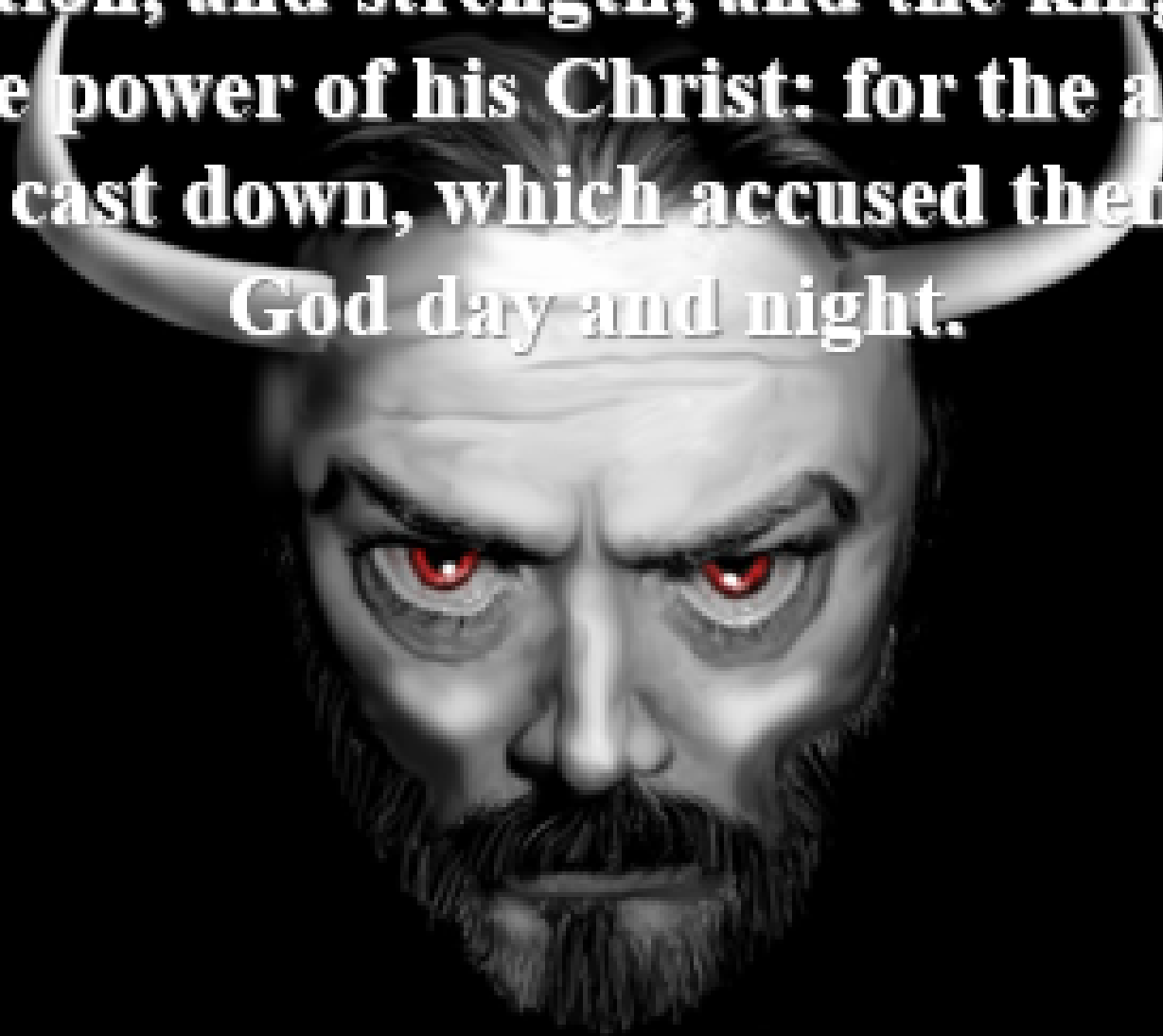
**12:9a - And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceives the whole world:**

**12:10 - And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is  
come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our  
God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our  
brethren is cast down, which accused them before our  
God day and night.**



**12:11 - And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.**



**12:12a - Therefore rejoice heavens, and you that dwell in them.**






**12:12b - Woe to the  
inhabitants of the earth  
and of the sea! for the devil  
is come down unto you,**



**...having great wrath,  
because he knows that  
he has but a short  
time.**



**12:13 - And when the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth, he persecuted the woman which brought forth the man [child].**

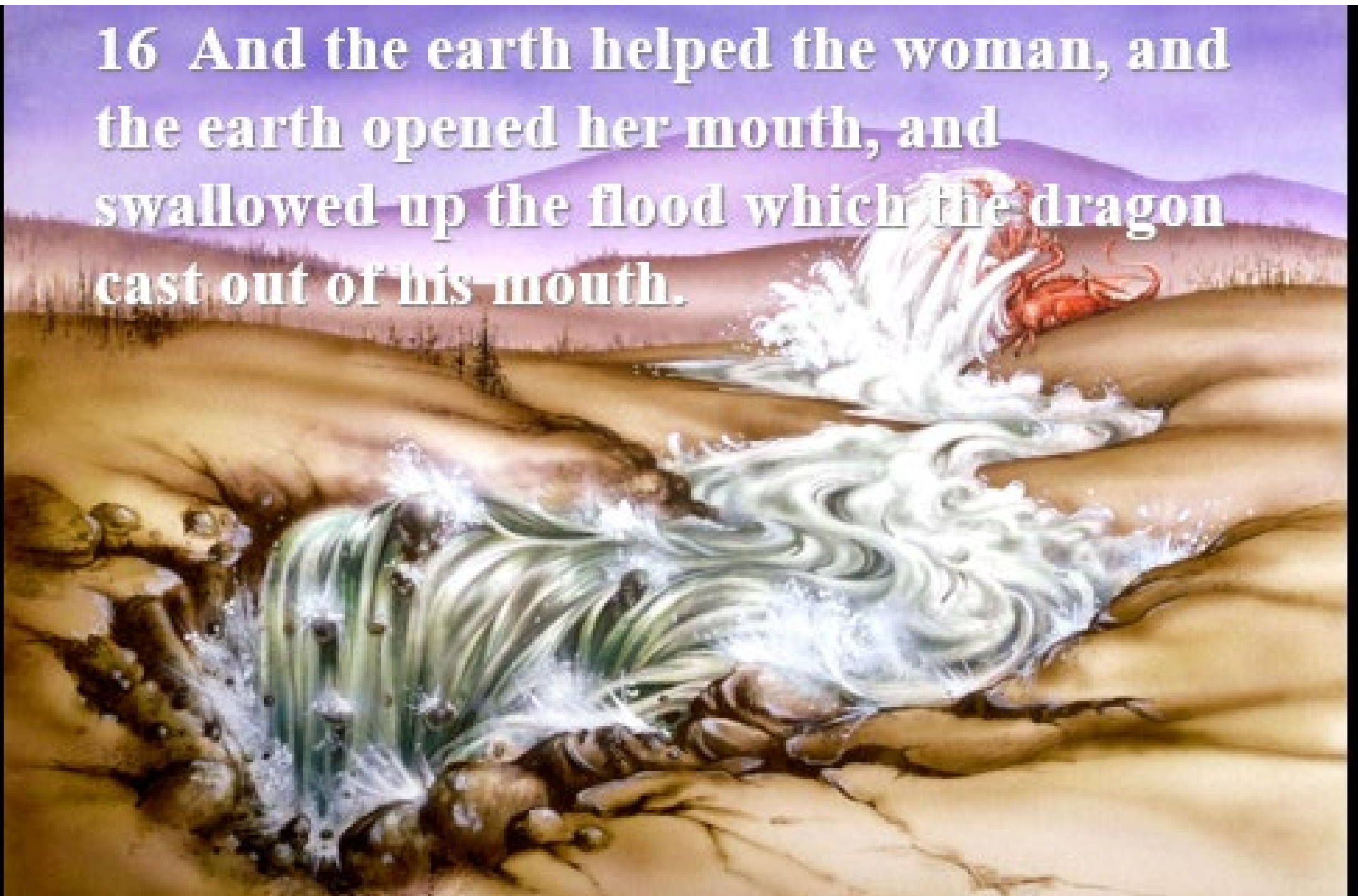
