Sermon: "The Church Fled When None Pursued!" What's Wrong With You People? Pt. 15

I Text:

Old Covenant: *Judges 6:1-10* New Covenant: *Romans 2:1-16* 

## II Doctrine:

The Book of Judges once again illustrates God's covenant sanctions concerning his people. God's people embraced the culture of the world and practiced sodomy, abortion, euthanasia, adultery, pedophilia, usury, etc. There are no innocent Nations when God pours out his wrath

The modern Church has declared all people innocent without repentance or sanctification. Modern evangelicalism has failed to teach the whole counsel of God. This is how God's people become corrupt like in the book of Judges. We are in the middle of God's judgment around the world. Apostate Christian nations are suffering the covenant curses including, invasive immigration, pestilence, and financial ruin.

God's people must focus on their own survival as his people, and repent now! Judgment starts at the house of God. We must beg God for forgiveness and rededicate ourselves to the laws of Jesus Christ. God will deliver his remnant if we call on his mighty name.

Apostate Christian nations are suffering the covenant curses including, invasive immigration, pestilence, and financial ruin. (*Judges 6:2-6*)
- 3) God's people must focus on their own survival as his people, and repent now! Judgment starts at the house of God. We must beg God for forgiveness and rededicate ourselves to the laws of Jesus Christ. God will deliver his remnant if we call on his mighty name. (*Judges 6:7-10; Romans 2:1-16*)
