Sermon: Satan the Sifter (Lk. 22.28-34)

<u>§1. Introduction</u>

- 1. **Doctrine:** Although members of the visible Church have continued with Christ for some time, and although they have a promise of heaven, yet they remain under the assaults of Satan who seeks to sift them out of the Kingdom of Christ and into apostasy.
- 2. **Application:** We will see our need to be on guard against the attacks of Satan against ourselves, our families, and our church and rely upon Christ our Intercessor and make use of remedies against Satan's devices. As we consider verse 31, we will examine three devices of Satan to draw us into apostasy, and three precious remedies against those devices.
