Disciples: What are they Like?

Review: A disciple of Jesus is a **constant apprentice.**

So, what are they like? They are like **<u>branches connected</u>** to the vine.

- 1. A disciple is born for **constant fellowship** with Jesus (Verses 1,5)
 - a. There is union and communion.
 - b. There is a mediated relationship.
- 2. A disciple undergoes **<u>continuous cleansing</u>** by the Father (verse 2)
 - a. Pruning is a process sometimes a **painful one**
 - b. Pruning has a purpose **increased** fruit bearing
 - c. Pruning is a **paternal prerogative** no self-pruning
- 3. A disciple lives in **continual dependence** upon Jesus. (Verses 4-6)
 - a. Some branches are **<u>barren</u>** attached but no fruit
 - b. Some branches are **<u>bountiful</u>** attached with some fruit
 - c. Some branches are <u>broken off</u> unattached without purpose.
 We must <u>abide to abound</u> "a branch cannot bear fruit of itself." (verse 4)
- 4. A disciple shows consistent fruitfulness through Jesus. (verses 7-8, 16)
 - a. Through faithfulness (abiding) prayers are sanctified.
 - b. Through fruitfulness **<u>God is glorified</u>**.
 - c. Through fruitfulness disciples are **identified**.
 - d. Through fruitfulness the world is **<u>evangelized</u>**. (verse 16)
- A disciple enjoys <u>contented fulfillment</u> through abiding in Jesus Love. (verses 9-11)
 - a. Happiness is based on **happenings**
 - b. Joy is based on **Jesus**.
 - i. Abide in His love
 - ii. <u>Obey</u> His word
 - iii. Rejoice in His promise.
