**C.H. Spurgeon** – 'Dear brethren, we ought to recollect that whatever service we have been able to render has been a matter of debt. I hope our morality is not fallen so low that we take

credit to ourselves for paying our debts. I do not find men in business priding themselves and saying, "I paid a thousand pounds this morning to such an one." "Well, did you give it to him?" "Oh no; (I owed it) to him." Is that any great thing? Have we come to such a low state of spiritual morals that **we think we have done a great deal when we give to God his due?** "It is he that made us, and not we ourselves."
