III. How are we similarly tempted?

- Lies, such as "you really would be happier running your own life rather than all that self-denial, purity, sacrifice stuff"
- Man-centered God: God exists to meet my needs
 The crown without the cross
- Man-centered ministry: a church that puts the Great Commission ahead of the Great Commandment
- Lack of horror at God being displaced so I forget Who is at the Center of my life (**Deut 6:4-15**) so compromise is not unthinkable
