 - a. Sign gifts: The sign gifts were
 <u>authenticating</u> gifts or gifts of credential for
 1st century Christians to authenticate their
 message.
 - b. Speaking gifts: Speaking gifts have to do with addressing people in an <u>audible way</u> the truths about the Bible.
 - c. Serving gifts: The <u>broadest</u> category of gifts
 most Christians fit in here.
- 3. God has given all people the **essential** gifts. (Rom 5:5-11)
 - a. The gift of His **Son.**
 - b. The gift of His **love**.
 - c. The gift of a sacrifice.
