Began his ministry in 626 BC.

After Josiah's death in 609, fewer allies, more rejection, ostracism, persecution as he spoke truths they did not want to hear:

- Repent of your evil
- God is on the side of the Babylonians! Do not resist them
- You and Jerusalem will be destroyed
