- How does that come to us?
- Paul mentions several things in which we exult, i.e., in which we rejoice. This implies the third and
 fourth fruits of our justification are joy and hope. In verses 2-3 what are two things in which we rejoice
 and from verse 2, in what do we have hope?
- Paul rejoiced in these things, do you? If so, discuss an example. If not, discuss why you don't.
- What is the fifth fruit Paul mentions as the result of our justification (5:9)?
- What is the final thing in which Paul exults? Do you similarly rejoice? If not, why not?
