Around 600 BC, God "reset" world history—replacing old empires with new empires.

Old Empires

Egypt – Pharaoh (slavery)

Israel – Solomon (idolatry)

Assyria - Sennacherib (185,000 died in one night)

Two Prophets of the Transition

Habakkuk

Ch. 1 – "Violence!"

Ans. Chaldeans (Babylonians)

Chs. 1-2 – "More wicked than us!"

Ans. All the proud will be punished.

Ch. 3 – "In wrath remember mercy."

Illus. Mountain deer agility—rejoicing in salvation through total economic collapse.

Jeremiah

Ch. 25 – If the city called by *God's* name is punished, all nations will be punished.

Reset Point

Ch. 31 – News of mercy in wrath: *The New Covenant*

- 1. Personal Transformation by God fixing the root of the problem
- 2. Personal Relationship with God every member of the covenant

Why?

"...for I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more" (Jer. 31:34). "This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood" (Jesus).

New Empires

Two Visions: The Four-Metaled Statue (Daniel 2) and the Four Beasts (Daniel 7)

Babylon - Nebuchadnezzar

605 BC – Battle of Carchemish

Medes and Persians – Cyrus (539 BC – against Babylon)

Greece – Alexander (333 BC)

Rome – Caesar (cf. Tsar, Kaiser,...) Jesus' favorite self-designation!

Phases: One, Two, Ten We still live in these days!

The Kingdom of God – one like the Son of Man

The Sovereignty of God vs. The Kingdom of God

Direct Rule

Indirect Rule via Man

What can we learn about man?

Human Government – Bestial vs. Humane

Illus. A just ruler in the fear of God is like sunshine causing grass to grow after the rain (2 Sam. 23:3-4).
