➤ When we've spiritually failed as believers, we should . . .

- See ourselves \_\_\_\_\_ as God sees us, not in our sin and failure. (Ephesians 1:3-7; Romans 8:37; 1 Corinthians 6:9-11; Colossians 3:1-4)
- Learn to rely upon God's \_\_\_\_\_ instead of ourselves. (2 Corinthians 3:5-6; 12:9-10; Philippians 4:13)
- Seek the will of God \_\_\_\_\_, realizing it's never \_\_\_\_\_ to be who God wants us to be and do what God wants you to do. (Matthew 6:33; 20:12; John 21:19-22; Ephesians 5:16-17)
- Seek a growing relationship with God, to \_\_\_\_\_ Him, \_\_\_\_\_ Him, and \_\_\_\_\_ Him. (Philippians 3:10-14)
