Q1: What level of error must be present before a "sect" or a "denomination" becomes a cult?

Typically Christian cults deviate from a proper comprehension of the following:

- Person of God, (trinity)
- Deity and work of Jesus Christ on the cross
- Humanity's sinfulness
- Salvation by grace alone through faith alone
- Authority of the Scriptures
