Introduction: The Bible has much to say about money:

It teaches us to earn it honestly (Prov. 10:2, 4)

To <u>view</u> it <u>soberly</u> (Prov. 8:10-12, 16:16)

& To give it cheerfully (2Co 9:7)

* How should Christians GIVE to the work of the Lord?

I. Give UNSELFISHLY

("the collection for the saints" - v.1)

II. Give REGULARLY

("upon the first day of the week" - v.2a)

III. Give PERSONALLY (Individually)

("let every one of you..." - v.2b)

IV. Give DECISIVELY

("lay by him in store" - v.2c)

V. Give PROPORTIONATELY

("As God hath prospered him" - v.2d)

The Principle of the <u>Tithe</u> (10%) (Gen.14:18-20; Lev.27:30; Mal.3:8-10; Mt.23:23)

The Principle of the First Fruits (Prov. 3:9-10)

The Principle of Sowing and Reaping (II Cor. 9:6; Gal. 6:7)

The Principle of Cheerfulness (II Cor. 9:"7; II Chron. 24:f10)

The Principle of Faith (II Cor. 9:8-15)

The Principle of Sacrifice (Lk. 21:1-4)

VI. Give ANONYMOUSLY

("that there be no gatherings when I come" - v.2c)

VII. Give RESPONSIBLY

("whomsoever ye shall approve...them will I send" - v.3-4)
