James 2:21-26 A Faith that Works—Part 2

Proposition: Saving faith has always been accompanied by works.

- 1. Abraham was justified by works when he offered Isaac. (2:21-24)
 - A. Abraham was shown to be righteous by what he did (2:21)
 - B. Faith is brought to its fullness through demonstrations of works (2:22)
 - C. Scripture itself was confirmed by what Abraham did (2:23)
 - D. No man can be shown righteous by mere profession (2:24)
- 2. Rahab was justified by works when she sent out the messengers (2:25)
- 3. Conclusion: saving faith must be accompanied by works (2:26)
