I. The Implication of His Resurrection (V8-10)

A. Verse 8

**Philippians 3:20-21 (NKJV)** "<sup>20</sup> For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>21</sup> who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself."

**Galatians 2:20a (NKJV)** "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me..."

**Philippians 3:10 (NKJV)** "that I may know Him and **the power of His resurrection**, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death".

**Philippians 4:13 (NKJV)** "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."

B. Verse 9

**2 Corinthians 5:21a (NKJV)** "For He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us..."

**2 Timothy 1:10 (ESV)** "and which now has been manifested through the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, **who abolished death** and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel".

**1 Corinthians 15:56a (NKJV)** "The sting of death *is* sin..."

**John 8:51 (NKJV)** "Most assuredly, I say to you, if anyone keeps My word he shall never see death."

**John 11:26 (NKJV)** "And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?"

**Hebrews 2:14-15 (NKJV)** "<sup>14</sup> Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, <sup>15</sup> and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage."

**Revelation 1:18 (NASB)** "and the living One; and I was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of death and of Hades."

C. Verse 10

**Ephesians 2:6 (NKJV)** “and raised *us* up together, and made *us* sit together in the heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus”.

II. The Appropriation of Our Identification (V11)

*Logizomai* – Reckon

**Romans 4:3-6 (NKJV)** “<sup>3</sup> For what does the Scripture say? ‘*Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.*’ <sup>4</sup> Now to him who works, the wages are not counted as grace but as debt. <sup>5</sup> But to him who does not work but believes on Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is accounted for righteousness, <sup>6</sup> just as David also describes the blessedness of the man to whom God imputes righteousness apart from works”.

A. We Are Dead to Sin (V11a)

B. We Are Alive to God (V11b)

**Galatians 2:20 (NKJV)** “I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.”
