Matthew 1:1-17

- I. The **Problems** with his genealogy
 - A. Can't Matthew count?!
 - 1. Each group was actually *more* than 14 generations

Solution:

- 2. The 3 groups that are listed are 14 14 13! Solution:
- B. Conflicts with Luke's genealogy (Lk 3:23-37) Why can't Matthew and Luke get their act together?!

Matt moves _____ from Abraham to Joseph
Luke " Joseph to Adam

No problems down to David. But Matt traces David → Solomon →

Luke traces David → Nathan →

Solution: Matt traces _____ line: royal legal right

Luke traces _____ line: biological spiritual right

Clue to this: **Jeconiah** (v11-12)

In Jer 22:30 he is cursed. So the Messiah must *legally* descend from him, but spiritually from another line

II. The **Purpose** of his genealogy

Fits two expectations; challenges two others

- A. Right ancestry: Son of David legally and spiritually
- B. New Age: Jesus inaugurates the Messianic Age

 $3 \times 14 = 42$: 6 sevens

Jesus is the beginning of the 7th seven: He inaugurates a New Age in history

C. For , not just "us Jews"

5 women mentioned: v3, 5, 6, 16 (that's unusual) First 4 are Gentiles grafted into Messiah's line

So WE need remember that the Gospel of Jesus is for ALL the world, not just for us

D. For , not just "good" people

Of the 5 women:

1. 2 immoral & unclean:

v3: Tamar: Genesis 38

v5: Rahab: Joshua 2

v16: Mary thought to be immoral

2. 2 hopeless & abused:

v5: Ruth: Bk of Ruth

v6: Bathsheba: II Samuel 11-12

v16: Mary's soul pierced by seeing her Son die

The Good News (Gospel) is that Jesus came for just such people. Only when we are honest about our hearts does the One Matthew will tell us about have something to offer us.
