All the evidence is in it is time for a decision.

- 1. Reasons for faith (v.19-21)
 - a. We can now come to God with **Confidence** v.19
 - b. We can now come to God by **life and not only death** v.20.
 - c. We can come because we have a High Priest **over** the house of God.
- 2. Responses of faith -(v.22-25)
 - a. Let us **draw near** by faith v.22– that would have never been said under the old covenant.
 - b. Let us **hold fast** to our hope in Christ. -v.23
 - i. Perseverance is a **characteristic** of true faith.
 - ii. Perseverance is **rooted** in God's promises. 1 Th 5:24; Phil 1.6; 2 Ti 1:12
 - c. Let us **consider** one another. (v.24-25)
 - Consider how we may <u>stir each other</u> to love and good works
 - ii. Consider how we may **exhort each other** to faithfulness in light of his coming.
 - 1. No one is right with the heavenly father that is not engaged with his earthly children. (1 Jn 4.20-21)
- 3. Reasons to fear (v.26-31) Remember, Jesus is God's complete message to man (1.1-4).
 - a. Willful rejection with full knowledge is to **deny the sacrifice** of Christ.
 - b. Willful rejection is to **trample the blood** of Jesus underfoot (6.4-6)
 - c. Willful rejection is to **disregard and despise** the blood of the new covenant.
 - d. Willful rejection is to **insult the Spirit of Grace**.
 - e. Willful rejection is to **invite the wrath** of the living God.
- 4. Responses to the gospel are only two. V.36 We can...
 - a. Draw back in doubt and perish
 - b. Draw near in belief for salvation.
