The Body of Christ, Spiritual Gifts, and Spiritual Maturity, Part 15 "Love Rejoices in the Truth" 1 Corinthians 13:6

The Apostle's Teaching on the Characteristics of Love – vv. 4-7 Overview:

- 1. Everything in these verses is behavioral.
- 2. Paul is interested to apply these things especially in relationships in the body of Christ.
- 3. Paul begins his portrait of love as it shows itself amidst the sins and offenses of a fallen world.
- 4. "Love" Gk. AGAPE
- 5. These things are impossible to the flesh! cf. Gal. 5:16-26

Love does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth!

1. What is Natural to the Flesh: Rejoicing in Iniquity

(1) Definitions

"love...does not rejoice in iniquity"

- Gk: KAIRE → KAIRO "to rejoice" "to delight"

ADIKIA "unrighteousness" NKJV and KJV: "iniquity ESV: "wrong-doing"

- Includes all forms of moral evil.
- Not to be taken here in the abstract sense; rather a particular sin displayed in a life.
- **Rejoicing in some sin, delighting in some evil upon hearing of it or learning of it.

 Particularly, some moral failure is in view.
- (2) Delighting in Evil What is in view.
 - -1- Outside of Christ, it is very natural to fallen man to delight in evil.
 - To approve of it in others; even to encourage it! cf. Rom. 1:32
 - To delight in hearing of someone else's moral failure.
 - -2- The believer can be guilty of a secret delight or a morbid interest in another's moral failure.
 - A fleshly thing!
 - One can be guilty of this while at the same time feigning moral indignation!
 - Registering a kind of sorrow while still being very interested in the details!
 - -3- This is at the heart of gossip: An inordinate delight in hearing of a brother's sins or stumbling or scandalous behavior.
 - This can be hidden away under the guise of "spiritual concern"
 - "I'll certainly pray! ... Tell me more!"

-4- One may enjoy endless discussions about what is wrong with the church

- Especially what is wrong with other churches!
- At the same time feeling a spiritual superiority.

-5- If my disposition toward my brother is not one of desiring his blessing:

- If I am envious toward a brother, I may delight in hearing of some moral failure.
- If I am at odds with a brother.
- If I am unduly critical of a brother and wish to tear him down (to build myself up).

2. What is Characteristic of Love: Rejoicing in the Truth!

(1) Rejoicing together in the truth

"but rejoices in the truth"

- A different verb for "rejoice" **SUGKAIRE** <u>SUG</u> = "together" + <u>KAIRE</u> = "rejoices"
 - "rejoices with the truth"
 - or "rejoices together (with others) in the truth"
- Fellowship in the body still very much in view here! cf. 12:26

(2) Rejoicing in the truth

- Not abstract!
- Rejoicing in the truth lived out! Some spiritual advance. An evidence of God's blessing!
- Particularly some spiritual advance seen in another brother or sister!

-1- Foundational to this: A Disposition of desiring blessing upon my brother sister.

- Praying for such blessing
- Ready to rejoice when God works

-2- Manifestations

- Rejoicing in the spiritual progress of another individual.
 - True repentance and faith
 - Progress in sanctification An evident increase in spiritual hunger
- Rejoicing in the spiritual progress of other covenant children.
- Rejoicing in the spiritual progress of another church (!)

-3- The Unity of the Church guarded and nurtured.

- When I truly rejoice in some spiritual advance in the truth, some progress, this brings me closer to my brothers and sisters.
- My brother certainly rejoices! Do I rejoice with him?
