In the Shadow of the Cross Pt. 5 The Super Natural Promise John 14:15

- I. The Super Natural Helper (vs. 15-17)
 - A. Not only, do not be troubled, but He sends you a Helper.
 - 1. The Holy Spirit
 - a) I am leaving, but I am not.
 - 2. Helper: One who walks alongside; never leaving, always encouraging, always correcting.
- II. The Super Natural Life (vs.18-19)
 - A. Knowing that He is coming close to the cross, Jesus displays concern for His disciples (vs. 18).
 - B. Jesus declares that though He will leave us to prepare a place for us, He will not leave us to ourselves (vs. 19).
 - 1. It is imperative to relish in the gift of receiving the Spirit and not grieving the Spirit. (1 Thes 5:19)
 - C. His resurrection is evidence of not just His deity, but also proof of our resurrection from sin death (vs. 19)
- III. The Super Natural Union (vs. 20-24)
 - A. "At that day" refers to His resurrection (vs. 20)
 - 1. And on that day the Union will be revealed.
 - B. Obedience of His commandments is evidence of a believers love (vs. 21-24)
 - 1. James 2:14-26
 - a) Evidence of faith THROUGH works. (vs. 21-25)
 - 2. Jesus is cutting out easy believism.
- IV. The Super Natural Teacher (vs. 25-26)
 - A. The Holy Spirit gives us the unification of scripture.
 - 1. To know God's word is to be empowered to by the Helper, to trust it as God's word.
 - a) Psalms 19:12-14
 - b) 2 Peter 1:19-21
- V. The Super Natural Peace (vs. 27-31)
 - A. You are not alone, you will be given the proper help to obey, **you will know peace in the midst of troubles.**
 - 1. Know Jesus, Know Peace

In closing. Verse 15. If you love Him, it will be evident. Is it?
