## The Birth of Isaac Genesis 21:1-7

## Main Point:

Depend on God's dependable Word through the power of your Savior.

1. God's Word is dependable.

2. God's Word is dependable, even when it doesn't seem to be.

3. Since God's Word is always dependable, you need to depend on it.

4. You can do this through Jesus, who depended on God's Word for you.

**2 Peter 1:3-4** <sup>3</sup> as His divine power has given to us all things that *pertain* to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, <sup>4</sup> by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises ... (NKJV)

**Genesis 17:19** <sup>19</sup> Then God said: "No, Sarah your wife shall bear you a son, and you shall call his name Isaac ... (NKJV)

**Genesis 17:10-12** <sup>10</sup> "This *is* My covenant which you shall keep, between Me and you and your descendants after you: Every male child among you shall be circumcised; <sup>11</sup> "and you shall be circumcised in the flesh of your foreskins, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between Me and you. <sup>12</sup> "He who is eight days old among you shall be circumcised ... (NKJV)
