

Bahnsen: What Scripture gives us, moreover, is not simply random bits of religious insight – theological and ethical 'conclusions' that we should affirm. It sets forth "the system of truth," an entire worldview that simultaneously reveals how we know what we know (epistemology), what the nature of reality is (ontology), and how we ought to live our lives (axiology).
