I. God's way is the best way.

- A. Homosexuality is against God's plan. (Matt. 19:4-6; Gen. 1:27; 2:24)

- B. Homosexuality invokes God's judgment. (Lev. 18:22; Rom. 1:27; I Cor 6:9-10; Rev. 21:8)

- C. Homosexuality is a form of idolatry. (Rom. 1:24-25)

II. God desires all men to repent and believe.

- A. Build redemptive relationships with unbelieving homosexuals. (Luke 19:10; I Cor. 5:9-13)

- B. Practice separation from "believing" homosexuals. (I Cor. 5:13; 2 Thess. 3:6-15)

III. God delights in setting captives free.

- A. You must reflect on His character. (I Cor. 10:12-13)

- B. You must rejoice in His power. (I Cor. 6:9-11)

- C. You must follow His commands. (Ps. 119:9-11)

- D. You must walk in His Spirit. (Phil. 2:12-13; Gal. 5:22-23)
