For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for you, the Gentiles – ² assuming that ¹ you heard of the stewardship, ² which is ³ the **grace** of God **given** to me for you, ³ that by revelation the mystery was made known to me (just as I wrote before in brief)... ⁶ that the Gentiles are ⁴ coinheritors and co-body-members and co-partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the good news, ⁷ of which I was made a servant by virtue of the **gift**, which is the **grace** of God **given** to me by virtue of the working ⁵ of His power. ⁸ To me, less than the least ⁶ of all holy ones, was this **grace given**: to tell the good news of the untrackable wealth of Christ... [Eph. 3:1-3, 6-8 DJP]
