Introduction:

- 1) Within the theological realm there is a word which you will hear tossed around quite a bit, the word, “**orthodox.**”
- 2) In the Greek language it is a compound word, the first part being “**ortho,**” which literally **means straight.** You see it in the word, “Orthopedic,” which describes a doctor who sets bones straight.
- 3) The second word comes to us from the root word “**dokeo,**” which primarily means to **believe or think.**
- 4) So literally, **orthodox** means to think or believe straight. We use it to describe **straight thinking or sound doctrine,** as opposed to twisted or unsound doctrine.

- 6) The name Jesus is derived from the Old Testament name Joshua, which means “Yahweh God is Salvation.”

- 7) The title Christ means one chosen and anointed by God to be the Messiah who delivers God's people.
