- II. Set free from sin and death, set free by the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus v. 2.
- III. Christ Jesus condemned, overcame sin in both our justification and sanctification. 3; 6:1, 2.
- IV. Established as those who walk by the Spirit, keeping God's Law, rejecting walking by the flesh. v. 4, 9; Jer. 31

Q. What is justification?

A. Justification is an act of God's free grace, where in he pardoneth all our sins, and accepteth us as righteous in his sight, only for the righteousness of Christ imputed to us, and received by faith alone.

Q. What is sanctification?

A. Sanctification is the work of God's free grace, whereby we are renewed in the whole man after the image of God, and are enabled more and more to die unto sin, and live unto righteousness.
