- A. God loves the evil world in spite of its rebellion against Him.

- B. God loves the needy world which is perishing. Ro. 6:23 Eph. 2:1ff
- C. God loves all people in a certain sense.
 - 1. He gives common grace blessings to all people. Mt. 5:43-48
 - 2. He offers the gospel to all without distinction. Jo. 3:16c 6:37b Rev. 5:9
- D. God loves His chosen people in a very special way.
 - 1. God does not love everyone equally. <u>Rom. 9:11-13</u> Am. 3:2 <u>Jer. 1:5</u> 31:3 Ps. 89:1-3 Dt. 4:37 7:7-8 10:15
 - 2. God's love is particular. He gave certain people to Jesus. <u>John 13:1 6:37,39 17:2,6,</u> 10:11,14-15,26-27
- E. God's saving love is consistent with His other attributes.
 - 1. God's love is sovereign. He does not owe His love to anyone. Rom. 9:15-16
 - 2. God's love is gracious and undeserved. The basis of God's choice has nothing to do with our worthiness. Dt. 7:7-8 II Tim. 1:9 I Jo. 4:19,10a
 - 3. God's love is eternal, having loved us from before creation. Eph. 1:3-6 Je. 31:3
 - 4. God's love for us is immutable and unending. Rom. 8:31-39 John 13:1
 - 5. God's love is infinite and unmeasurable. Eph. 2:4 3:14-19
 - 6. God's love for us is holy and just. Ro. 3:21,26

- B. God's love is costly -- He gave His unique Son to die for sinners. I Jo. 4:10

- C. God's love is purposeful -- He sent His Son that we would not die, but live.

 - 3. God sent His Son that we might have everlasting life. 1:1:4 3:36a 14:6 Eph. 2:4-5
 - 4. We are saved exclusively by God's love. Phil. 3:8-9 I Jo. 4:9
- D. We should love as God loves -- actively, sacrificially and purposefully. John 14:15 Eph. 5:25ff I Jo. 4:19,11-12 I Cor. 13:4 Phil. 2:3ff

IV. How can you gain the benefits of God's love?

- A. Faith is the condition of receiving the life God offers us in Christ.
 - 1. From the human side -- Those who would believe. 6:37b
 - 2. From divine side -- All those the Father gave Him will come. 6:37a 10:27
 - 3. Jesus laid down His life for His beloved sheep. <u>10:11,14-15,26-27</u> Eph. 5:25 Rev. 5:9 Mark 10:45
- B. Those who believe can never be separated from His love. Ro. 8:31-39 Ps. 100:5
- C. Those who have experienced such love are able to truly love. 13:35 I Jo. 4:19,7-8,12 Eph. 3:14-19 Ro. 5:5 Gal. 2:20
- D. Those who reject God's love in Christ will perish in their sin. v. 16,18-20
