What did Cain & Abel offer to God (Gen. 4:3–5)?
Who else do we see bringing offerings in the OT?

(Noah – Gen. 8:20–21, Job 1:5; Abraham...)

Hebrews 11:4-6

⁴ By faith Abel <u>offered to God a more acceptable sacrifice</u> than Cain, through which he was commended as righteous, God commending him by accepting his gifts. ...

⁶ And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would *draw near to God* must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.

1 Peter 2:4–<u>5</u>

What is a New Covenant "holy priesthood"? What are "spiritual sacrifices"?

How can we make sure these are "acceptable to God"?

Today's Biblical Bullet...

God is pleased when...

we offer Jesus as our unblemished lamb and ourselves as living sacrifices.

1 Peter 1:15

but as he who called you is holy, <u>you also **be holy** in all</u> your conduct...

> A Call to Worship: The Where, Who & What of Worship

<u>Where</u> do We Worship? (OT vs. NT) Deuteronomy 12:11

...to <u>the place that the Lord your God will choose, to</u> make his name dwell there, there you shall bring all that I command you: your <u>burnt offerings</u> and your sacrifices, your <u>tithes</u>...

⁴ As you (pl.) come (present participle) to him, a living stone...⁵ you (pl.) yourselves like living stones are being built up as a <u>spiritual house</u>...

- Therefore...We are the Place... (Gathered & Scattered) (Cf. Understanding The Congregations Authority)

<u>Who</u> Can Worship? Who Has Been Appointed...?

⁵ you (pl.) yourselves... are being built up... to be *a <u>holy</u> priesthood*...

> Jesus is Our High Priest (Cf. Heb. 4:14–5:4; 6:19–20)

Priesthood of All Believers!

Hebrews 10:19-22

¹⁹ Therefore, brothers, *since <u>we have confidence</u> to enter <u>the holy places</u> <u>by the blood of Jesus</u>, ²⁰ by the new and living way that he opened for us <i>through the curtain*, that is, <u>through his flesh</u>, ²¹ and since we have a great priest over the house of God, ²² let <u>us</u> draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, <u>with our hearts sprinkled clean</u> from an evil conscience and <u>our bodies washed with pure water</u>.

<u>What</u> do We Offer to God in Our Worship? "sacrifices"

...to offer *spiritual sacrifices* acceptable to God *through Jesus Christ*.

What make our "sacrifices acceptable to God"?

1st - We Offer Jesus to God "...through Jesus Christ"

Jesus is Our Sin/Burnt Offering...

Hebrews 13:10–16

¹⁰ We have an <u>altar</u> from which those who serve the tent <u>have no right to eat</u>. (Cf. Lev. 6:30) ¹¹ For the bodies of those animals whose blood is brought into the holy places by the high priest as <u>a sacrifice for sin</u> are burned outside the camp. ¹² So Jesus also suffered outside the gate in order to sanctify the people through his own blood.

What specifically did Jesus offer to God? Hebrews 10:5–7

⁵ Consequently, when Christ came into the world, he said, "Sacrifices and offerings you have not desired, but a body have you prepared for me; ⁶ in burnt offerings and sin offerings you have taken no pleasure.⁷ Then I

said, '**Behold, I have come to do your will**, O God, <u>as it</u> is written of me in the scroll of the book.' "

Jesus Offered His Obedient Life to God We Offer Jesus' Obedient Life to God

We Offer Jesus to God in Our Gathered Worship...

- ✓ We Thank God for <u>What We Have</u>... (Prayers/Songs of Adoration, Thanksgiving)
- ✓ We Trust God for <u>What We Need</u>... (Confession, Intercession)

We Offer Jesus to God Every Day... (in Jesus Name)

- ✓ When We Acknowledge & Give Thanks to God
- ✓ When We Give & Receive Forgiveness

In Jesus We Trust & Hope

2nd – We Offer God Ourselves "spiritual sacrifices"

- > From the OT Picture to NT Reality (The Holy Spirit)
 - ✓ The Priests (Washed: Ex. 29:4; 30:17–21)
 - ✓ Grain Offering (Salt: Lev. 2:13)
 - ✓ The Altar (Fire)

Hebrews 13:10-16

¹³ Therefore let us go to [Jesus] outside the camp and bear the reproach he endured. ¹⁴ For here we have no lasting city, but we seek the city that is to come. ¹⁵ *Through him* then *let us continually offer up a sacrifice* of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that acknowledge his name. ¹⁶ *Do not neglect to do good and* to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God.

Summary: Jesus is for us and in us!

[We] offer <u>spiritual</u> sacrifices acceptable to God <u>through Jesus Christ</u>.

What Does Christian Worship Look Like?

...Fired at our Life & Heart Offering Spiritual Sacrifices We make it <u>our aim</u> to please God by giving our entire lives to God *while* <u>trusting</u> Jesus for us & in us.
