**Message 39. Your Kingdom Come – Matthew 6:10**

Intro: As Jesus gives His disciples instructions about how to pray by giving them “The Lord’s Prayer”, He is actually giving a pattern for us upon which to build all our prayers. More than reciting this one prayer we find in it principles and the purposes behind all prayer. The first 3 petitions are adoration of God!

- I. Your Kingdom Come – the Reign of God
  - A. Today’s Definition
    1. “The realm over which a king rules.”
    2. “The people over whom a monarch reigns.”
  - B. Archaic Definition – Ezra 8:1; 2 Chron. 12:1; Dan. 8:23
    1. “The authority and sovereignty exercised by a king.”
    2. “The authority to reign.”
    3. See an example of the transfer of rule - the kingdom was not destroyed because the kingdom was not the realm or the people, but the right to rule – Dan. 5:21, 25-31
  - C. The Right to Rule – Luke 19:11-12 (Herod/Rome)
  - D. God’s Reign, Rule, and Sovereignty – Ps. 103:19; 145:11; Dan. 2:37
- II. The Kingdom has Come and yet is Coming
  - A. It has Come – Matt. 3:2; 4:17
    1. It is in the World – Luke 17:20-21
    2. It is not of the World – John 18:36
  - B. It is Present Now
    1. In the World – Matt. 13:11, 18-23, 41, 43-50

  - B. You Must Seek It – Matt. 6:33; Rom. 3:10-11; Luke 19:10
  - C. You Must Be Righteous – Matt. 5:20; Gal. 5:5; Rom. 3:21-23
  - D. You Must Be Obedient – Matt. 7:21; John 14:15; Matt. 7:24-27

Conclusion: 1) This is prayer that affirms that we are “looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God” – 2 Peter 3:11-13

2) This is a statement of fact and also a petition for the success of the gospel – an “all-inclusive missionary prayer.” “Our innermost and greatest desire should be the desire for God’s honor and glory. At the risk of being misunderstood I suggest that our desire for this should be even greater than our desire for the salvation of souls. Before we even begin to pray for souls, before we even begin to pray for the extension and the spread of God’s kingdom, there should be that overruling desire for the manifestation of the glory of God and that all might humble themselves in His presence.” – Martyn Lloyd-Jones, *Studies in the Sermon on the Mount*, pg. 339

MENE: God has numbered your kingdom, and finished it; 27 TEKEL: You have been weighed in the balances, and found wanting; 28 PERES: Your kingdom has been divided, and given to the Medes and Persians." 29 Then Belshazzar gave the command, and they clothed Daniel with purple and put a chain of gold around his neck, and made a proclamation concerning him that he should be the third ruler in the kingdom. 30 That very night Belshazzar, king of the Chaldeans, was slain. 31 And Darius the Mede received the kingdom, being about sixty-two years old.

43 Then the righteous will shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. He who has ears to hear, let him hear! 44 "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and hid; and for joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.
