- I. Be rightly related to God (having a deep reverence & love for Him) (Deut.6:4-6)**
(Lord, help me to walk with you, for their sakes)

To manage my family well, I must...

- II. Fulfil my responsibility to teach my family God's Word (Deut.6:7)**
(Lord, give me the grace to train my family in your ways)

To manage my family well, I must...

- III. Control the influences that come into my home (Deut.6:8-9; Ps. 101:2-3)**
(Lord, keep all wicked things out of my house; may it be adorned with your precepts)

To manage my family well, I must...

- IV. Provide for my family's physical needs of food, clothing, shelter, & protection (1Tim.5:8)**
(Lord, give me strength to work to meet my family's necessities)

To manage my family well, I must...

- V. Pray for my family every day (Job 1:5; Phil.4:6)**
(Lord, may I meet with you every day for their well-being)

To manage my family well, I must...

- VI. Prepare for my family's future success (Ps.78:1-8; 1 Cor.7:36-38)**
(Lord, I will be responsible for their academic training and their marriage arrangement)

To manage my family well, I must...

- VII. Be committed to them no matter what (Malachi 2:15-16)**
(Lord, I will never leave them, nor forsake them)

- VIII. Serve my Lord together with my family (Joshua 24:15)**
(Lord, assist me to lead my family in the paths of righteousness)
