# III. Resignation -

#### A. The Word of the Lord -

- <u>Jer. 6:10</u> To whom shall I speak, and give warning, that they may hear? <u>behold</u>, their ear is uncircumcised, and <u>they cannot hearken</u>: behold, <u>the Word</u> of the LORD <u>is unto them a reproach</u> (i.e. shame); they have <u>no delight</u> in it.
  - Jer 4:4 <u>Circumcise yourselves</u> to the LORD, and take away the foreskins of your heart, ye men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem: lest <u>my fury</u> come forth like fire, and burn that none can quench it, <u>because of the evil</u> of your doings.
  - Pr 14:31  $\P$  He that oppresseth the poor <u>reproacheth</u> his Maker: but he that <u>honoureth</u> Him hath mercy on the poor.
  - Delight (emotional) Why? Dignity, Deity, Destiny, Duty
- 11 Therefore I am full of the fury of the LORD; I am weary with holding in: I will pour it out upon the children abroad, and upon the assembly of young men together: for even the husband with the wife shall be taken, the aged with him that is full of days.
- 12 And their <u>houses</u> shall be turned unto others, with their <u>fields and wives</u> together: for <u>I will stretch out my hand</u> upon the inhabitants of the land, saith the LORD.

## B. The Work of Iniquity –

13 For from the least of them even unto the greatest of them every one is given to <u>covetousness</u>; and from the prophet even unto the priest every one dealeth falsely.

Covetousness - Hezekiah (Isa 38:12) & Job (6:9); ripped off by ripping off

- Col 3:5 Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry:
- 14 <u>They have healed</u> also the hurt of the daughter of my people slightly, <u>saying</u>, <u>Peace</u>, <u>peace</u>; when there is no peace.
- 15 Were they ashamed when they had committed abomination? nay, they were not at all ashamed, neither could they blush: therefore they shall fall among them that fall: at the time that I visit them they shall be cast down, saith the LORD.

abomination - loathesome, detestable, thing of horror > Le 18:22-30; Le 20:13

### C. The Willfulness of Man

- 16 Thus saith the LORD, <u>Stand ye</u> in the ways, and see, and <u>ask</u> for the old paths, where is the good way, and <u>walk</u> therein, and ye shall find <u>rest</u> for your souls. <u>But</u> they said, We will not walk therein.
  - Pr 29:1 He, that being often reproved hardeneth his neck, shall suddenly be destroyed, and that without remedy.
- <u>Jer 8:4</u> ¶ Moreover thou shalt say unto them, Thus saith the LORD; <u>Shall they</u> fall, and not arise? shall he turn away, and not return?
- 5 Why then is this people of Jerusalem slidden back by a perpetual backsliding? they hold fast deceit, they refuse to return.
- 6 I hearkened and heard, but they spake not aright: no man repented him of his wickedness, saying, What have I done? every one turned to his course, as the horse rusheth into the battle.
  - Isa 53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.
  - Ps 32:9 Be ye not as the horse, or as the mule, which have no understanding: whose mouth must be held in with bit and bridle, lest they come near unto thee.

### D. The Wickedness of the Wise

- 7 Yea, the stork in the heaven knoweth her appointed times; and the turtle and the crane and the swallow observe the time of their coming; but my people know not the judgment of the LORD.
- 8 <u>How do ye say,</u> We are wise, and the law of the LORD is with us? Lo, certainly in vain made he it; the pen of the scribes is in vain.
- 9 The wise men are ashamed, they are dismayed and taken: lo, they have rejected the word of the LORD; and what wisdom is in them?
- 10 Therefore will I give their wives unto others, and their fields to them that shall inherit them: for every one from the least even unto the greatest is given to covetousness, from the prophet even unto the priest every one dealeth falsely.
  - Hab 1:13b holdest Thy tongue when the wicked devoureth the man that is more righteous than he?
- 11 For they have healed the hurt of the daughter of my people slightly, saying, Peace, peace; when there is no peace.
- 12 Were they ashamed when they had committed abomination? nay, they were not at all ashamed, neither could they blush: therefore shall they fall among them that fall: in the time of their visitation they shall be cast down, saith the LORD.
