In 1941 an english scholar named j.b. Phillips began a new translation of an old piece of literature. He got much more than he planned on when he connected with the new testament for war torn england. His testimony is in the preface to the phillips new testament:

"first, i was continually struck by the living quality of the material i worked on. Some will no doubt consider it superstrrious reverence for the "holy writ", yet again and again i felt rather like an electrician rewiring an ancient house without being able to turn the mains off". I feel this fact is worth recording. Secondly, i was struck by the extraordinary unanimity of the letrers. In different ways from their different angles they are talking about the same thing. In conclusion, maybe if we believed what they did it would effect us!"

There are 3,000 pages of material printed every 60 seconds in the USA. In that mountain of information only one book is:

Witness there ever will be or a lie.

There are some extraordinary moments recorded flawlessly in the

Word of god. Have you ever realized what it means that these words

Were god-breathed? Only he was there to record them...

- How about your origin? Creation="no one but god" Genesis 1-2
- How about coming judgment? Flood = "eight in a billion" gen 6-8: 7:23.
- How about current middle east tensions? Call of abram="the man from ur"
- Gen 11-12:1

- How about your struggle with some secet sin? Temptation of joseph = "from inside of Potiphar's house" Genesis 37,39:11
- How about your fear of the future or death? Jacob's testimony="israel's last words" Genesis 48:15-49.
- How about worries about accidents? Death of Ahab, "A bow at random" 1 Kings 22:34-38 And a certain man drew a bow at a venture, and smote the king of Israel between the joints of the harness: wherefore he said unto the driver of his chariot, Turn thine hand, and carry me out of the host; for I am wounded. 35 And the battle increased that day: and the king was stayed up in his chariot against the Syrians, and died at even: and the blood ran out of the wound into the midst of the chariot. 36 And there went a proclamation throughout the host about the going down of the sun, saying, Every man to his city, and every man to his own country. 37 So the king died, and was brought to Samaria; and they buried the king in Samaria. 38 And one washed the chariot in the pool of Samaria; and the dogs licked up his blood; and they washed his armour; according unto the word of the LORD which he spake. - I. There are 66 books:
 - A. The Old Testament has 39 books with 939 chapters and different Hebrew words
 - B. The New Testament has 27 books with 250 chapters and different Greek words
 - C. This translates into just over 6,000 different

- English words
- D. No less than 2,930 people are mentioned (W.M. Smith)
- E. The CHAPTER DIVISIONS were made by Stephen Langton the Archbishop of Canterbury in he 1200's. The VERSE DIVISIONS came in 1550 by Robert Estienne, who fled for his life from France to Calvin in Switzerland.

 - D. Because of its fulfilled prophecy (illustration Logos Esch.)
 - E. Because of its scientific accuracy (Mac)
 - F. Because of its archaeological verification (Criswell)
 - G. Because of its endurance through the ages (Criswell)
