Responsive Reading

Leader: Which is the eighth commandment?

People: The eighth commandment is, Thou shalt not steal.

Leader: What is required in the eighth commandment?

People: The eighth commandment requires the lawful procuring and furthering the wealth and outward estate of ourselves and others.

Leader: What is forbidden in the eighth commandment?

People: The eighth commandment forbids whatsoever does, or may, unjustly hinder our own, or our neighbor's wealth or outward estate. (Shorter Catechism 73-75)

Corporate Confession of Sin

Leader: Divine Judge and Shepherd of the Sheep, by nature we are sinful. We were born in sin and continue to sin.

People: We confess together that we have stolen from others, that we have been greedy for earthly treasures and lusted after frivolous entertainments.

Leader: We freely admit our love for the world and for the things of the world.

People: Hide your face from our sins, O God, and blot out all our iniquities.

All: Cast us not away from your presence. Do not take your Holy Spirit from us. Restore to us the joy of your salvation.

Private Confession of Sin (silent)

Assurance of Pardon

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9)
