I. Conversion

-Definition: A turning from sin [repentance] to God [faith in Christ] (Acts 15:3; 26:18)

-Ruth was converted (Ruth 1:15, 16; 1 Thess. 1:9).

-Four Observations:

- Biblical conversion is the inevitable result of the new birth (1 John 3:9; 5:1).

- Biblical conversion is radical in nature.

- Biblical conversion results in supreme attachment to Christ (Matt. 10:37; 19:29; Luke 14:26).

- Biblical conversion is the thing that must happen to you if you hope to enter heaven (Matt. 18:3; John 3:3, 7).
