- (2) In time to come: Escape from "Babylon!"

- 3. Sing and Rejoice!

"Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion, for behold, I come and I will dwell in your midst,

(1) Salvation Blessings Flow! I come and I will dwell in your midst, declares the LORD."
