The Love in the Love Feast 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 (NASB)

Two Characteristics

Love is patient love is kind

Seven Contrasts Contrasted by Self-interest (Kind)

is not jealous;
love does not brag
is not arrogant,
does not act unbecomingly;
it does not seek its own,

Contrasted by Hostility (Patient)

is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong suffered,

The Right Joy

does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth;

Four Commendations

bears all things, (Patient)
believes all things, (Kind)
hopes all things, (Kind)
endures all things. (Patient)
