## The comfort of God to His chastened people (1-11)

- Comfort summarized (2b)
  - Your hard labor for sin is over
  - $\circ$   $\quad$  Your penalty for iniquity has been accepted as paid off
  - $\circ$   $\hfill The Lord has given an exact payment for your sin$
- Messages of comfort (3-11)
  - Voice #1: Be comforted through preparing with repentance for the coming of the Lord in salvation (3-5)
  - Voice #2: Be comforted by the promise of the Lord's coming in salvation because God's Word stands forever (6-8)
  - Voice #3: Be comforted with the goodnews that your
