I. God's grace is "SAVING" grace

A. God's grace is "OTHER-SHEEP" saving grace

Act 15:11 But we believe that through the **grace** of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved, even as they.

B. God's grace is "ON-PURPOSE" saving grace

2Ti 1:9 Who hath saved us, and called *us* with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and **grace**...

C. God's grace is "TO-HIS-GLORY" saving grace

Eph 1:4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world...

Eph 1:5 Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,

Eph 1:6 To the praise of the glory of his **grace**...

D. God's grace is "SINNER-FIXING" saving grace

Eph 1:6 ...wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.

Eph 1:7 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his **grace**;

E. God's grace is "PROPHET-BAFFLING" saving grace

1Pe 1:10 Of which salvation the prophets have enquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the **grace** *that should come* unto you:

F. God's grace is "JUSTIFYING" grace

1. God's grace is "RANSOM-PAYING" justifying grace

Rom 3:24 Being justified freely by his **grace** through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus

2. God's grace is "HEIR-MAKING" justifying grace

Tit 3:7 That being justified by his **grace**, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

G. God's grace is "EFFECTUAL-CALLING" grace

1. God's grace is "LIFE-GIVING" effectual calling grace

Eph 2:5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by **grace** ye are saved;)

2. God's grace is "BORN-AGAIN" effectual calling grace

Gal 1:15 But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called *me* by his **grace**,

3. God's grace is "BELIEF-CAUSING" effectual calling grace

Act 18:27 ...when he was come, helped them much which had believed through **grace**:

4. God's grace is "JESUS-FOLLOWING" effectual calling grace

1Co 15:10 But by the **grace** of God I am what I am: and his **grace** which *was bestowed* upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the **grace** of God which was with me.

H. God's grace is "SIN-ABOUNDING" grace

Rom 5:20 Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, **grace** did much more abound:

I. God's grace is "DEATH-REIGNING" grace

Rom 5:21 That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might **grace** reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord.

II. God's grace is "GOD-BECOMING-A-MAN" grace

A. God's grace is "HEAVEN-LEAVING" grace

2Co 8:9 For ye know the **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.

B. God's grace is "TASTING-DEATH" grace

Heb 2:9 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the **grace** of God should taste death for every man.

Heb 2:10 For it became him, for whom *are* all things, and by whom *are* all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

Heb 2:11 For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified *are* all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren,

Heb 2:12 Saying, I will declare thy name unto my brethren...

Heb 2:13 ...Behold I and the children which God hath given me.

III. The gospel of grace

A. God's grace is "WORTH-PREACHING" grace

Act 20:24 But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the **grace** of God.

B. God's grace is "NONE-OTHER-GOSPEL" grace

Gal 1:6 I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the **grace** of Christ unto another gospel:

Gal 1:7 Which is not another; but there be some that...would pervert the gospel of Christ.

C. God's grace is "DON'T-FRUSTRATE-GRACE" grace

Gal 2:21 I do not frustrate the **grace** of God: for if righteousness *come* by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.

D. God's grace is "NON-MAN" grace

Rom 11:6 And if by **grace**, then *is it* no more of works: otherwise **grace** is no more **grace**. But if *it be* of works, then is it no more **grace**: otherwise work is no more work.

E. God's grace is "GRACE-ALONE" grace

Heb 13:9 Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines. For *it is* a good thing that the heart be established with **grace**...

IV. God's grace is "FAR-REACHING" grace

A. God's grace is "ALL" grace

1Pe 5:10 But the God of all **grace**, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle *you*.

B. God's grace is "SUFFICIENT" grace

2Co 12:9 And he said unto me, My **grace** is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

C. God's grace is "GOOD-HOPE" grace

2Th 2:16 Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given *us* everlasting consolation and good hope through **grace**,

2Th 2:17 Comfort your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work.

D. God's grace is "HELP-FROM-HEAVEN" grace

Heb 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of **grace**, that we may obtain mercy, and find **grace** to help in time of need.

E. God's grace is "GREAT-GRACE" grace

Act 4:33 ...and great grace was upon them all.

F. God's grace is "EXCEEDING-GRACE" grace

2Co 9:14 ...which long after you for the exceeding **grace** of God in you.

G. God's grace is "MORE-GRACE" grace

Jas 4:6 But he giveth more **grace**...

H. God's grace is "GRACE-FOR-GRACE" grace

Joh 1:16 And of his fulness have all we received, and **grace** for **grace**.

V. God's grace is "GOOD-WORKS" grace

A. God's grace is "HARD-WORKING" grace

1Co 15:10 ...his **grace** which *was bestowed* upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the **grace** of God which was with me.

B. God's grace is "EVERY-GOOD-WORK" grace

2Co 9:8 And God *is* able to make all **grace** abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all *things*, may abound to every good work:

C. God's grace is "GOD-SERVING" grace

Heb 12:28 Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have **grace**, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear:

D. God's grace is "MAN-SERVING" grace

Rom 12:6 Having then gifts differing according to the **grace** that is given to us...

E. God's grace is "HELPING-THE-POOR" grace

2Co 8:7 Therefore, as ye abound in every *thing*, *in* faith, and utterance, and knowledge, and *in* all diligence, and *in* your love to us, *see* that ye abound in this **grace** also.

F. God's grace is "BE-STRONG" grace

2Ti 2:1 Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the **grace** that is in Christ Jesus.

G. God's grace is "CONTINUE-IN-GRACE" grace

Act 13:43 ...who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in the **grace** of God.

H. God's grace is "NO-SIN" grace

Rom 6:1 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that **grace** may abound?

I. God's grace is "NOT-OK-TO-SIN" grace

Jud 1:4 For there are certain men crept in unawares...ungodly men, turning the **grace** of our God into lasciviousness...

J. God's grace is "DARE-NOT-INSULT" grace

Heb 10:28 He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses:

Heb 10:29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant...an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of **grace**?

VI. God's grace is "GRACE-THAT-CAME" grace

Joh 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us...full of **grace** and truth.

VII. God's grace is "GRACE-TO-COME" grace

1Pe 1:13 Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the **grace** that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;
