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PECA Sermon Outline on Exodus 24:1-11, August 10, 2014

Intro:

<u>Main Point of Text:</u> God calls His people to formally commit to Him together under His rule; they covenant with God in blood, and so receive and celebrate the blessing of God's life and fellowship.

<u>Sermon Point:</u> *Celebrate the Covenant of Grace.*

Move 1: Rejoice that God calls you into a covenant relationship with Him.

Ratification of the covenant: <u>vss. 6-8</u>. Covenant: agreement/pact. Two parties facing one another in formal ceremony of commitment. Establishes a relationship. Blood seals the deal (altar, God's glory; pillars, God's people, vs. 4). Meal typical of such suzerain covenants (vs. 11). Means of reference. Imposed by God, but consent desired/required for real relationship: Ex. 19:5, 8: initiated, established. Here, confirmed.

Move 2: Rejoice that God calls you into covenant with Him together.

Nation represented by Twelve Tribes: vs. 4. Federal headship representation: priests, and "seventy elders" (vss. 1, 9): commit their people, receive the symbol of people's reception (just like Ex. 3:16; 4:29; 12:21; 17:5-6; 19:7). Vss. 3, 7: All the people are there, respond with one voice in agreement (with children).

Move 3: Resolve to worship and serve your covenant God with righteous reverence.

<u>Reverence</u>: vs. 1: approach at distance, "come up" and "bow down". Vs. 2: people separated from the Mediator who alone goes up (like Ex. 19:21; 20:21). Vs. 4: Early morning, built an altar: must approach through atonement. Vs. 10: describes only manifestation). <u>Righteous</u>: Proclaimed Book of the Covenant to people: <u>vs. 7</u>. 19-24, or 21-24?. Mainly, Membership Vows. Contract of loyalty and obedience. Vss. 3, 7: "we will do": "obedient" (Like Ex. 19:8-9). Moses wrote <u>all</u> words of the Lord. Deut. 4:7-8/Ps. 147:20).

Move 4: Receive and remember the covenant with solemnity and security.

Blood of the Covenant, <u>vss. 6</u>, <u>8</u>. <u>Solemnity</u>: blood is shed. <u>Security</u>: seals the deal. Janzen: blood = willingness to lay down life for the sake of the relationship. Calvin: blood increases the sanctity and security of the covenant. Matthew 26:28. Jesus laid down His life, for you His friends, to sanctify you and seal you: <u>Hebrews 9:14-28 (allusion to 18-21)</u>. Thus, <u>Hebrews 13:20-21</u>

Move 5: Recognize your privilege and purpose as covenant people and be thankful.

<u>Vs. 11</u>: Eat/drink: meal. Pink, peace offering: "happy fellowship". See God and live! (Gen. 32:30; Ex. 33:20). <u>Vs. 10</u>: heavenly dwelling (sapphire tiles), pure, pristine, high, holy, glorious. Life. Romans 5:21: ... as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord.

Conclusion:

Lord's Supper is "Eucharist", thanksgiving.

Celebrate the Covenant of Grace.
