Week in Review: (Suggested Sharing Time 10 minutes)

• How did God inconvenience you this week for you to SEE others? What was the result?

Discussion Starter: (Suggested Time 5 minutes)

• How has someone demonstrated love to you in the past? How did that make your feel?

Sermon Review: (Suggested Time 15 minutes)

Read John 13:34-35 and discuss the following questions:

- Who was Jesus speaking to and how did He demonstrate His love for them?
- Why would this have been considered a new commandment?
- Why would loving one another prove they were Jesus' disciples?

Why would Paul widen the scope of who we are to love in 1 Thessalonians 3:12?



<u>Digging Deeper:</u> (Suggested Time 20 minutes)

Read Matthew 22:37-40 and discuss the following questions:

- Why is loving God the greatest commandment?
- Why is loving others the second greatest commandment?
- How does the rest of Scripture hinge on these two commandments?

Read Romans 13:8-10 and discuss the following questions:

- What does it mean to owe nothing to anyone except love?
- How does loving your neighbor fulfill the requirements of the law?
- Why does love do no wrong to others?

Application: (Suggested Time 10 minutes)

- Have you accepted God's love and grace for you? If not, would you like to?
- How can you demonstrate love for other Christ-followers this week?
- Continue to ask God to inconvenience you so you can demonstrate His love to others.
